A shorter version is available for independent candidates that prefer to only attend the first 45 minute session each week. This can also be offered through a webinar. If candidates select this option, they will have to prepare all the tasks from one week to the next. If all tasks are not completed week by week, the candidate will be dismissed from the program at no refund.

General Comments

Orientation

DIA will hold an internship orientation, covering workplace practices in Australia, visa requirements, workplace skills, appropriate dress and behaviour for the internship, and the internship process. A handbook will be emailed to each student prior to arrival/orientation and is expected to be read and brought to this orientation session.

Placement

There is currently a high level required for any jobs, internships and contracts in Australia, the competition is fierce. In this regard, our Host Companies are often requesting direct applications form applicants/candidates. This means that no Host Company will take interns that are not submitting applications directed to the specific company. Therefore, DIA are also changing and accommodating. DIA will now help all candidates/students prepare all the necessary documentation for submission to the company. A DIA representative will meet with the student in person or online and help with the preparation of the required documents. DIA will ensure that the documents are at a high level. To be clear, **DIA are not promising an internship or work assignment**. What we can promise is to help to get the internship or assignment by supporting the candidate closely. The DIA representative will be available by phone, email and Skype throughout the application process and during the possible placement.

• The candidate and the DIA representative will meet regularly to assure all documents are prepared in time.

Students should be realistic about their role in the office, as appropriate to their skills and experience. Students should also understand that reasonable standards of dress will be required, possibly meaning purchase of a suit, lab coat, field gear etc as appropriate.

<u>Monitoring</u>

DIA will happily take an active role in the intern's progress including visiting the office and telephone/email support. At a minimum, student's must submit the journal mentioned above so that progress can be monitored and to encourage early resolution of any settling in issues. However, the intern is expected to take responsibility for their own learning. They must look at how to organise their internship, take advantage of the situation and learn from the opportunities presented to them, all which is covered in the orientation session.

The intern must understand that the Host Company as well as DIA is committed to give them an educational experience of a life time, a stepping stone between student and work life in an international environment, and must therefore show the same commitment in return.

A De-brief will be offered to individual students, over the phone, or in groups on completion of their internship. Either way, the intern must part take in a de-brief. This is to the best for the intern as it prepares them for what to expect post the internship, assists in how to improve their resumes and use the contacts and experience they have made in Australia, and also on how to approach work life.

<u>Visas</u>

Interns must have a valid work or student visa and must send a copy of this to DIA prior to commencing the internship program.

Insurance

The intern is liable to take out compulsory health and travel insurance to cover them throughout the entire internship. If applicable, the interns may also have to take out personal liability insurance. The insurance must be provided a minimum of 7 days prior to commencing the internship (the sooner the better). Insurance papers should be sent to your internship coordinator and to the Host Company supervisor. Interns should also keep an electronic copy for themselves.

Certificate of Achievement

Students will receive a non-credit bearing Certificate of Achievement on successful completion of their internship. This certificate will be awarded by Dream Internship as well as the Company the intern has worked for. The Certificate will include number of hours or weeks worked in conjunction with references by both the company and Dream Internship. Credit bearing Certificates will be handled by the student's university.

Celebration

Dream Internship encourages all interns to celebrate their wins and achievements. This celebration may be part of the de-brief or will be discussed at the orientation in line with the interns goals!
